"When they are diving, at top speed that is very low," said one U.S. official.

"They seemed to come down to the tree tops," a British official said.

Some Soviet jets skimmed so low they appeared to be heading for open windows and motorists and pedestrians ducked in terror.

An eyewitness said a Soviet jet buzzed a Hamburg-bound Pan American World Airways airliner over West Berlin after it took off from Tempelhof Airfield. A spokesman for the airlines, whose operations here have not been affected by a current Pan Am pilots' strike,

Mother Nature Causes Power Outages Here

Mother nature went on a brief rampage—through Lodi last night, knocking out power in the northwest section of town for as long as 90 minutes in some areas.

City electrical crews were still working late in the night on one circuit which had been broken, apparently by a tree branch falling through the span.

The wind and rain also caused short circuits in some 15 other lines at various locations over the entire town, creating brief power outages until circuit breakers were restored.

The victim was David Carl Hackwell. His mutilated body was found an hour and a half after the attack was believed to have occurred.

County Commissioner John Preston Creer viewed the body shortly after it was discovered. "It was one of the worst things I've ever seen," Creer said.

He said the child had gone outside to play. The dog apparently broke loose and jumped the youngster.

The dog, weighing about 40 pounds, was acquired by Hackwell about a month ago. Deputies said the animal would be destroyed.
