Pit Bull Dog Kills Girl; Owner Charged

FRESNO (AP) — Criminal charges have been filed against the owner of a pit bull dog that killed a 6 year old girl last month. Deputy Dist. Atty. John Ambry said Thursday that Eric Johnson, 20, of Fresno, has been charged with owning an animal responsible for the death of a human being because of the owner's neglect.

The girl, Misty Lee, was attacked May 15 when she apparently wandered up to the dog which was chained and padlocked to a carport pole at the back of an apartment complex.

A pathology report said the child died of a severed jugular vein and a broken neck. The child's mother said the girl grew up with dogs and would have approached the 70 pound animal without hesitation.

Ambry said a warrant would be issued for Johnson's arrest and that the court would order that the dog be destroyed. Johnson could face a maximum of five years in prison if convicted. The dog is being held at a Fresno animal shelter.
